The story of the angel appearing to Mary, known as the Annunciation, is found in the Bible's Gospel of Luke (1:26–38)

The greeting: The angel Gabriel appeared to Mary in Nazareth and greeted her with "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you". Mary was troubled and wondered what this meant.

The promise: The angel reassured her, saying, "Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus". He was to be great, called the "Son of the Most High," and would reign over the house of Jacob forever.

Mary's question: Mary asked, "How will this be," she asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?".

The explanation: The angel explained that the Holy Spirit would come upon her and the power of the Most High would overshadow her, so the child would be holy and called the Son of God.

The confirmation and acceptance: The angel added that her relative Elizabeth, who was considered barren, was also six months pregnant, showing that "Nothing, you see, is impossible with God". Mary responded, "I am the Lord's maid, ready to serve. Let it be with me, just as you say".

The departure: After Mary's acceptance, the angel left her.
