As my wife and I finalize our trip plans to Israel. I am reminded of the joy in Psalm 122:1 "I was glad when they said unto me, let us go into the house of the LORD." What a blessing it is to walk the very land where the Lord's footsteps were and where His promises were lived out in real history. In Romans 15:19, the Apostle Paul declares his commitment to preach the Gospel from Jerusalem and beyond, "Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ."— a reminder that this land remains central to our faith and testimony.

In recent years, modern discoveries continue to bring ancient realities into sharper focus. In the Golan Heights, archaeologists have unearthed a 1,500-year-old synagogue, revealing a vibrant community of worship that stood for generations and echoing the enduring faith of God's people. At Kafr Kassem, a luxurious 1,600-year-old Samaritan estate with intricate mosaics was uncovered, illustrating the rich cultural and religious diversity of Late Antique Israel. May this journey deepen our understanding of God's work through the ages, strengthen our faith in His unending word, and draw us closer to the Savior whose life and love transformed this very land.

Step 1: Text "Give" to (539) 210-3116.

\*There are 3 options to give through texting:

- 1) A number to tithe that amount.  
Example, "100"
- 2) A number and fund to designate your gift: Example, "100 payoff"
- 3) A number and schedule for automated giving: Example, "500 Monthly," "100 Payoff Bimonthly," "50 Tithe Weekly"
- 4) "Cancel auto" to cancel automated giving.
- 5) Add "cover" to cover fees of one transaction: Example, "100 Tithe Cover."
